NNMH 2017-18 Season Fundraiser Contract

1. Each child's parent/guardian is responsible for selling raffle tickets and turning in the money by January 1, 2018. The exact number required to sell will be determined based on registration numbers. Ten tickets are roughly what has been required for one player. For families with more than one player, more may be required to be sold.
2. Each child's parent/guardian is responsible to work in the snack bar during practices; games; public skating; varsity games; tournaments; sectionals/states; and special events during the hockey season. Snack bar shifts will be assigned and monitored to ensure that the shifts are being covered.
 - If you do not show for your assigned snack bar shift or do not have someone cover the shift for you, you will owe the association:
 - **\$25.00** per each missed snack bar shift for team practices.
 - **\$50.00** per each missed snack bar shift for team games; public skating.
 - **\$75.00** per each missed snack bar shift for varsity games; annual tournaments; and/or sectional/state games.
 - Snack bar shifts will be checked on a routine basis & those who missed their assigned shift will be billed accordingly.
 - Head coach does not have to work the snack bar for the child of the team he/she is coaching, unless they volunteer to do so.
 - Assistant coaches do not have to work the snack bar during that team's practices and games.
 - No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the concession stand.

Snack Bar Buy Out: If you do not want to work in the snack bar, there are buyout options:

1. Buyout of working in the snack bar for team practices; team games; and public skating for **\$250 per child**.
 2. Buyout of working in the snack bar for varsity games; our annual tournament; possible sectional/state tournaments; and special events for **\$250.00 per child**.
3. Each 10U, 12U, 12UG, 14U, 14UG family will be required to work in the snack bar during the association's annual tournament, sectional/state tournament regardless of whether or not your child's team is participating in the tournament. The 8U and LTS families will be required to work any Mite Day; Jamboree; and mini-tournaments they may have. Midgets are exempt from working the snack bar.

The Hockey Board will strictly enforce this policy in fairness to each family that is participating.
